
Raise: pump using the full range of movement.



Electric raising and lowering




Hand rest and backrest









Attach the safety belt




Attach safety belt to the transfer handle (A).

Press down to lock it.




Position the patient.




Adjust the safety belt



Pull the fastening clips (A) and (B) apart by twisting the smaller fastening clip (A) slightly upwards.




Loosen the safety belt: pull the inner strap (A) at the side and at the same time lifting the larger fastening clip (B).




Tighten the safety belt: pull the outer strap (A) at the side and at the same time holding the larger fastening clip (B)

Remove the safety belt



Lock the fastening clips by inserting the smaller fastening clip (A) into the larger fastening clip (B).



Loosen the safety belt and remove one of the ends from the transfer handle (A) or the knob (B).
