




## **Product Overview**





Pull the Clip attachments in the direction of the arrow


Use the handset to move the resident support arms

If necessary, pull up the Emergency lowering knob

If necessary, push the red emergency stop button

- 1. Fit the sling to the resident, ensuring correct size is used. Ensure chest strap is fastened securely and residents arms are outside the sling.
- 2. Position the SARA 3000 in front of the resident, open the chassis legs if necessary, assist in placing residents feet on the foot support with the knees touching the kneepad and allow resident to hold hand grips.
- 3. Adjust height of resident support arms to its lowest position.
- 4. Attach the sling to the SARA 3000 and put under tension before lifting.
- 5. Using the handset or dual control, raise the resident to a standing position.
- 6. Close legs and transport resident to chair, bed or toilet.
- 7. Position the resident in front of chair, bed or toilet with the back of their legs gently touching e.g. the chair and lower to a sitting position.
- 8. Release tension on the sling and remove sling from the SARA 3000.
- 9. Remove the SARA 3000, taking care to remove the residents feet from the foot support.
- 10. Remove the sling from around the resident.
